





Using Zoom Functions for Assessments




This handout demonstrates screening sharing when using the Zoom application and using a web browser.

Here is task bar on the Zoom Workplace application:




To share your assessment:

- Open the assessment in a new window
- Select 'Share'



- Select 'Advanced'
- Select 'Portion of screen' then 'Share' at the bottom of the screen











The portion in the green box is shared. It will be orange when you are moving it. Adjust the box to fit the assessment

Once set, it will remember the portion of the screen shared for next time.














Use 'Annotate' to give non-verbal cues









Use a spotlight arrow to show where you are pointing

Click 'x' on the arrow to remove it













Screen sharing when joining from a web browser

If you use a browser, you can share a tab to reduce the content on the screen.

You cannot annotate when screening windows or tabs











Other content Zoom can shared when using the app:

- Entire desktop or phone screen
- One or more specific applications
- Content from a second camera
- Whiteboard
- A locally stored video
- Audio played from device
- iPhone/iPad screen
